





- A neutral palette brings a level of simplicity and sophistication into a space.




### Accent Colors














1932 Building | Walnut Wood Floor

Cluster Accent Wall Diagram | Option 1




Highlight of Collaboration Area, Corridor Wall with Color & One Teaching Wall




Cluster Accent Wall Diagram | Option 2





