Mr. Chairman and members of the Committee, my name is Stephen Cordi, Deputy Chief Financial Officer for the Office of Tax and Revenue. I am pleased to present testimony today on Bill 18-0043 "The 14W and the YMCA Anthony Bowen Project Real Property Tax Exemption Act of 2009."

Bill 18-0043 would provide a ten-year real property tax exemption, followed by a ten-year phase out of that exemption and a sales tax exemption for materials used directly in the project.

The exemption is intended to support the development of a mixed-use residential, retail, and garage project on 14<sup>th</sup> Street Northwest, as well as the construction of a new YMCA on the site. A significant portion of the site is currently tax-exempt, however the new residential and retail development on the site would be taxable without this exemption. The OCFO has not completed a fiscal impact analysis of this legislation, but the fiscal impact statement will show a revenue loss that would need to be included in the budget and financial plan.

The Office of the Chief Financial Officer has no position on the merits of Bill 18-0043. We do have a few technical concerns which I have conveyed to Mr. Steven Hernandez of Council Member Graham's staff. I am grateful for the time which he spent in discussing our concerns and his receptiveness to my suggestions. I would be pleased to work with the staff of this Committee as well to make sure that this legislation, if enacted, will accomplish its intended purpose.
