FY 2020 Approved Budget Changes

Homeland Security Grants' approved FY 2020 gross budget is \$1,323,169, which represents a 23.3 percent decrease from its FY 2019 approved gross budget of \$1,724,516. The budget is comprised entirely of Intra-District funds.

The Homeland Security and Emergency Management Agency sub-grants support several multi-year federal grants to various District agencies through the Intra-District budget authority process. Homeland Security Grants is the vehicle used to track and record the Intra-District transactions with various agencies. Prior to FY

2014 budget formulation, budget authority was not given until after the beginning of each fiscal year. To avoid the delay in making funds available at the beginning of the fiscal year, the agency proposes an Intra-District budget of \$1,323,169 in nonpersonal services, with no FTEs.

Furthermore, the breakdown by program of the multi-year Memoranda of Understanding (MOUs) is as follows: two agencies within the Homeland Security Grants (Public Safety) program totaling \$1,214,419, which includes the Metropolitan Police Department and Office of Unified Communications and one agency within the Homeland Security Grants (Human Support) program totaling \$108,750.

Mayor's Proposed Budget

Decrease: Homeland Security Grants' FY 2020 budget proposal in Intra-District funds reflects a decrease of \$401,347 across multiple programs. Of this amount, a decrease of \$128,547 is in the Homeland Security Grant (Public Safety) program and a decrease of \$272,800 is in the Homeland Security Grants (Human Support) program. The decreases are primarily a result of projected carry-over of multi-year sub-grant awards issued by the Homeland Security and Emergency Management Agency to District agencies from FY 2019.

District's Approved Budget

No Change: The Homeland Security Grants' budget reflects no change from the Mayor's proposed budget to the District's approved budget.
