Central Collection Unit (CCU) Customer Requirements

In-Person Visits to the CCU:

In order to enter the building and conduct business with the CCU, the customer must have one of the following **valid** forms of **photo identification**:

- Driver's License or Government issued photo identification;
- U.S. Passport or U.S. Passport Card;
- U.S. Military identification with photo and DOB;
- Immigrations Green Card, or Permanent Residence Identification with photo and DOB

Proof of District Residency Status:

In order to be considered a valid District of Columbia resident, the CCU currently follows the same requirements as the DC-DMV. For additional information regarding District Residency requirements, please contact the DC-DMV at (202) 737-4404 or refer to the website link below:

Valid CCU Payment Methods:

- Cash
- Money Order, Bank Check, or Treasurer's Check made payable to DC Treasurer
- Valid Visa or Master Card must be in name of debtor and must have valid photo ID. If using another person's valid credit card, that person must be present and have a valid photo ID at the time of the transaction
